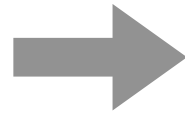

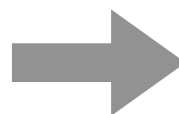

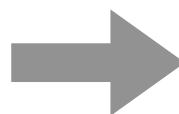

## The London Guide

London is the most attractive city in the world and many tourists visit this city every year. It's known for its convenient transportation system such as the Tube (the subway), double decker buses, and taxis. *Rent-a-bike* is getting popular among visitors these days. The reason so many visitors visit London is that it has a great number of wonderful sightseeing spots!

Here are three fantastic attractions in London.

If you are interested in history and art, you should visit The British Museum. The Museum galleries are open daily from 10:00 to 17:30, and most are open until 20:30 on Fridays. The British Museum has more than 150,000 exhibits, including the famous "Rosetta Stone." You need at least one day to look at all the exhibits! If you are busy doing other sightseeing in London and just want to look at the "Rosetta Stone," it will take about one hour.

We strongly recommend that you see "The Changing of the Guard." The guards wear red uniforms with big black hats. This ceremony takes place outside Buckingham Palace from 10:45 and lasts around 45 minutes and it is free to watch. You can see it every day in summer, but in winter it takes place on Mondays, Wednesdays, Fridays and Sundays, weather permitting. The ceremony is cancelled when large events are held in the city centre. During the summer, you can tour 19 spectacular rooms inside the palace. These magnificent rooms are decorated with some of the greatest treasures from the Royal Collection, including paintings by Rembrandt, Rubens and Van Dyck.

The London Eye is also very popular and you can enjoy spectacular views from the top of this attraction. It's located in the centre of London, near the Houses of Parliament and Big Ben. At a height of 135 meters, the London Eye is the world's tallest ferris wheel, high enough to see up to 40 kilometers on a clear day. The London Eye has 32 capsules and each one holds up to 25 people. It takes 30 minutes for one revolution and you can see many of London's famous landmarks from the top.
